Fall 2022 Policies

Our Responsibilities

We will teach your child the language and enjoyment of music. Our studio has a positive, enthusiastic and inspiring environment. Curriculum is tailored to match your child's specific learning needs.

Student & Family Responsibilities

Students agree to arrive at each lesson punctually, well-prepared, and with their assignment books and music. To make good progress, quality practice is necessary. We want your child to completely understand every assignment. Please ask questions.

If your child is experiencing anything at home or at school that might interfere with their ability to focus and learn during their lesson, please notify us so that we can accommodate the needs of your child. A quick text on the way to lesson can make the difference between a great lesson and a difficult one. (Did Max just find out that he didn't get the part in the play? Give us a heads up. Was Jane hospitalized on your recent trip to Thailand? Let us know!) We don't expect personal/private details, but even a general idea gives us the ability to adjust our approach for your child.

Cancellation Policy

- Any lesson that a teacher cancels will be made up.
- No payment credit or makeup lessons will be provided for students who miss lessons for any reason.

Try to choose a lesson time in which you feel confident. Please understand that the tuition you pay reserves an exclusive weekly time in the schedule for your child.

To help accommodate an occasional unavoidable change in student's schedules, you can choose to be part of the cell phone Switch List. (Please let us know if you do not want to be included in the list.) Most parents receive only a few requests a year from someone who would like to switch lesson times. If this is something you are interested in, please let your child's teacher know.

If your child is sick, or contagious (as in they have strep and have been on antibiotics for 20 hours), but feels well enough to do a lesson, skype, zoom, and facetime are all options. Please let your child's teacher know so this can be set up.

Termination Policy

In the event a student decides to terminate lessons, a two week notice is required, along with any fees that are due up to the point of termination.

Inclement Weather

In the event we are experiencing a weather event to include flooding, tornado warnings, snow and/or ice on the roads, lessons can be done virtually or made up at a later date.

Tuition

Tuition for **a 30-minute lesson** for the semester is \$625 and consists of a total of 20 lessons. Number of lessons and tuition will be adjusted for those enrolling in the middle of the semester. Tuition payment schedule options are:

- Five (5) monthly payments of \$125 due on the 1st of each month;
- Two (2) payments of \$307.50 due on August 1st and September 15th (a \$10 discount);
- One (1) payment of \$603 due August 1st (a \$22 discount)

Tuition for **a 45-minute lesson** for the semester is \$940 and consists of a total of 20 lessons. Number of lessons and tuition will be adjusted for those enrolling in the middle of the semester. Tuition payment schedule options are:

- Five (5) monthly payments of \$188 due on the 1st of each month;
- Two (2) payments of \$463 August 1st and September 15th (a \$14 discount);
- One (1) payment of \$907 due August 1st (a \$33 discount).

A late fee of \$25 will be incurred for tuition that has not been paid by the 7th of each month for those choosing the five (5) monthly payment option.
